


Artificial Intelligence

SAM ALTMAN ON CHATGPT VS. BING


- Sam Altman: Yeah, <u>Chat GPT is a horrible product</u>... if you think about the way people want to integrate it into their workflow, the way that you want it to be able to use your own data, to integrate with your other applications and services, people are really just going to a site that sometimes works and sometimes it's down. They're typing in something. They're trying to get until they get it right. And they're copying the answer, and going to paste it somewhere else, and then going back, and trying to integrate that with search results. Or there are other workflows.
- It is cool, for sure. And people really love it, which makes us very happy. But no one would say this was a great, well-integrated product yet.
- Casey Newton: It's not the 1.0 version.
- Sam Altman: Yeah, it's the 0.7 or something like that. But there's so much value here, that people are willing to put up with it. And this [Bing] is a real product now.








What new discoveries from the James Space Webb Telescope can I tell my 9 year old about?



Your 9-year old might like these recent discoveries made by The James Webb Space Telescope (JWST):

- In 2023, The JWST discovered a number of galaxies nicknamed "green peas." They were given this name because they are small and round, like peas.
- The telescope captured images of galaxies that are over 13 billion years old. This means that the light from these galaxies has been traveling for over 13 billion years to reach us.
- JWST took the very first pictures of a planet outside of our own solar system. These distant worlds are called "exoplanets". Exo means "from outside".
- These discoveries can spark a child's imagination about the infinite wonders of the universe

Seeing is not always believing: A Quantitative Study on Human Perception of Al-Generated Images

Photos serve as a way for humans to record what they experience in their daily lives, and they are often regarded as trustworthy sources of information. However, there is a growing concern that the advancement of artificial intelligence (AI) technology may produce fake photos, which can create confusion and diminish trust in photographs. This study aims to answer the question of whether the current state-of-the-art AI-based visual content generation models can consistently deceive human eyes and convey false information. By conducting a high-quality quantitative study with fifty participants, we reveal, for the first time, that humans cannot distinguish between real photos and AI-created fake photos to a significant degree 38.7%. Our study also finds that an individual's background, such as their gender, age, and experience with AI-generated content (AIGC), does not significantly affect their ability to distinguish AI-generated images from real photographs. However, we do observe that there tend to be certain defects in AI-generated images that serve as cues for people to distinguish between real and fake photos. We hope that our study can raise awareness of the potential risks of AI-generated images and encourage further research to prevent the spread of false information. From a positive perspective, AI-generated images have the potential to revolutionize various industries and create a better future for humanity if they are used and regulated properly.


